Understand steps to access

Article 5 countries, submitting project proposals via bilateral or multilateral implementing agencies, can request MLF resources to implement early actions on HFCs. Upon receipt of a project proposal submitted by an Article 5 country, the Secretariat will send it to the Implementing Agency if so designated by the country. The Implementing Agency will establish the necessary contacts with the Article 5 country concerned and elaborate the project documentation to meet all the necessary requirements. The Secretariat will evaluate the project documentation for submission to the Executive Committee.

Countries are encouraged to consult with the Secretariat during the course of any project preparation in order to produce comprehensive and consistent documentation. Identify what activities are eligible for readiness support

To receive MLF funding, Article 5 countries must identify and prioritize activities based on the Fund's eligibility criteria for this funding envelope, and obtain the approval of the Executive Committee.
