

AFD FACILITY FOR SUPPORTING NDC IMPLEMENTATION

A NEW FACILITY TO TACKLE THE CHALLENGE OF NDC IMPLEMENTATION

AGENCE FRANÇAISE DE DEVELOPPEMENT (AFD) is launching a **30M€ Facility** that will support the implementation of Nationally Determined Contributions (NDC) in approximately **15 vulnerable countries** (LDCs, Africa and SIDS).

The objective is to help meet **developing countries needs** mentioned in the INDC, **make the Paris Agreement operational**, to **align with the national public policies** and to **foster the urgent upscaling of climate investments** in the short term.

For international donors such as AFD, NDCs are structuring and become the new dialogue framework. They enable discussions with country partners about the shift of their development model towards a low-emission and resilient pathway.

A Facility with 3 main components

The AFD Facility will:

- help enhance countries climate governance capacities
- support translation of NDC into sectorial policies and action plans
- help countries to identify and finance structural adaptation projects

Multi-actor cooperation

AFD will implement this Facility in close cooperation with national governments and other actors through partnerships with international and local experts and notably with **Expertise France** for activities related to countries climate governance capacities.
