SUMMARY OF SUPPORT FOR NDC IMPLEMENTATION

Through the NDC Leadership Compact, the U.S. government will collaborate with developing countries to make substantial and rapid progress in achieving mitigation targets as reflected in their NDCs. The NDC Leadership Compact also aims to showcase leadership by these countries with NDC implementation so they serve as regional and global role models and inspire replication of their successful approaches by other countries.

UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT

A team of experts from across U.S. agencies will provide technical assistance and share U.S. experiences, knowledge, and resources for NDC implementation with participating countries.

The United States will also coordinate with other donors and international institutions and networks under the Compact.

Enable learning and replication by other countries, through advisory support, exchange of experiences, and other means

The U.S. will partner with 15 or more countries in Africa, Asia, and Latin America and the Caribbean.

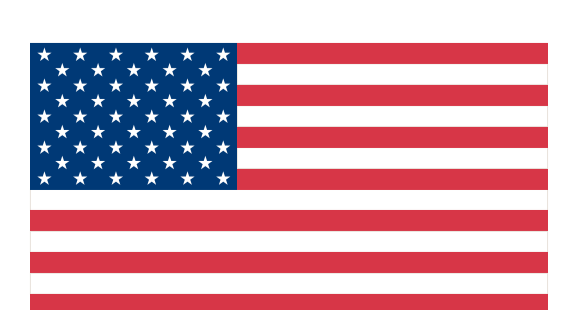
